The Central Bank of the UAE announced that it will be issuing with effect from Wednesday 30/ 11 /2011, a commemorative Gold and a commemorative Silver coin on the occasion of the 40th Anniversary of the Establishment of the United Arab Emirates.

The face of the two coins depict the portrait of H.H. Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Al-Nahyan "may Allah protect him", circumscribed by the expression "H.H. Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Al-Nahyan President of the United Arab Emirates", Written in Arabic, While the back of both the commemorative coins depict a silhouette of the iconic image of the founding fathers of the United Arab emirates, led by the late Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan and the expression "Spirit of The Union " " The 40th National Day" - "United Arab Emirates", written in Arabic and English.

Each gold coin will be sold at the gold price on the day of sale plus the additional costs estimated at AED (100), while the silver coin will be sold at its face value plus the additional costs estimated at AED (100) .
